

# Creswell Station Loop

A 1.8 mile circular walk from Creswell Railway Station on the Robin Hood Line.



This will take you in towards the Town Centre, passing links North to the Clowne Greenway and onwards towards Model Village, before returning to the Railway Station.




Route connection to Clowne Greenway




Pathway towards Clowne Greenway
